READ THIS NOTICE CAREFULLY AS IT MAY AFFECT YOUR RIGHTS

This notice is directed to all persons who had a contract with Lojack Canada Enterprises ULC for a LoJack branded tracking device with a termination date after June 30, 2020, and who did not obtain a reimbursement for the advances paid to LoJack Canada following the termination by LoJack Canada of its services in Canada as of June 30, 2020.

On July 6, 2026, the Superior Court of Quebec approved the class action settlement with LoJack Canada.

Please carefully read the linked notice of a class action proceeding on behalf of Quebec consumers against LoJack Canada, which has been settled with approval from the Court.

In accordance with the court-approved settlement, LoJack Canada will provide each class member who files a claim and is deemed eligible to recover with a reimbursement of the advances paid to LoJack Canada in proportion with the remaining period of their contract as of June 30, 2020.

NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT APPROVAL

The Class Action Proceeding

On or about August 20, 2020, an application for authorization to institute class action lawsuit was filed by a Quebec consumer (the "**Applicant**") against LoJack Canada Enterprises ULC ("**LoJack Canada**"). The Applicant alleged that LoJack Canada acted in violation of the *Consumer Protection Act* of Quebec and the *Civil Code of Quebec* when it informed customers that it would no longer provide a service that had been paid for in advance without automatically providing reimbursement. These allegations were never proven in Court and are contested by LoJack Canada.

The Group is : All natural and legal persons domiciled or formerly domiciled in the Province of Québec who (i) entered into a fixed-term contract for services of successive performance with the Defendant for a LoJack Branded Tracking Device with a termination date after June 30, 2020; and (ii) as at June 30, 2020, owned or leased a vehicle in which a LoJack Branded Tracking Device was installed pursuant to said contract; and (iii) that were not reimbursed for advances made to the Defendant in excess of the services that were received following termination by the Defendant of said contract as of June 30, 2020;

The Court-Approved Settlement

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that, on July 6, 2026, the Superior Court of Quebec approved a settlement agreement (the "**Transaction**") with LoJack Canada.

Pursuant to the terms of settlement, LoJack Canada agrees to pay each Class Member who files a Claim and is deemed eligible to recover (the "**Eligible Class Member**") a reimbursement of the advances paid to LoJack Canada in proportion of the number of days remaining on such Eligible Class Member's Contract as of June 30, 2020 minus a deduction of 2% for the Fonds d'aide aux actions collectives (the "**Individual Award Amount**").

Class Counsel has also sought and obtained Court approval of its extrajudicial fees in the amount of \$25,000.00 plus applicable taxes, subject to adjustment to amount to at least 20% of the Total Award Amount to be paid by the LoJack Canada to Eligible Class Members. In this regard, if 20% of the Total Award Amount exceeds \$25,000, the difference between 20% of the Total Award Amount and \$25,000 will be deducted by the Claims Administrator from the Total Award Amount and adjust the Individual Award Amounts accordingly.

As part of the Transaction, LoJack Canada has received from the Applicant and the other Class Members who have not validly opted out a full release of any and all claims made in the Application.

Claims Process

If you believe that you are eligible to receive such monetary compensation, you must follow the Claims Process.

First, you must submit a duly completed Claim Form, which will be made available on the following websites:

In the Claim Form, you must confirm the facts that apply to your situation, and which make you eligible as a Class Member, namely that:

1. you entered into a Contract with LoJack Canada;
2. as of June 30, 2020, you owned or leased a vehicle in which a LoJack Branded Tracking Device was installed pursuant to the Contract; and
3. you were not reimbursed for the advances paid to LoJack Canada in excess of the services that you received following the termination of the Contract by LoJack Canada as of June 30, 2020.

Second, attached to the Claim Form, you must submit Proof of Claim, namely:

4. a copy of one valid identification document (driver's licence, health card, or passport);
5. your Contract, or any evidence that proves that you owned or leased a vehicle in which a LoJack Branded Tracking Device was installed as of June 30, 2020 and that the Claims Administrator deems acceptable (for example, bank statements, insurance policy, vehicle maintenance invoices or other proof of installation of the device by an authorized third-party, the letter from the Defendant regarding the end of services, etc.); and
6. any other document that the Class Member deems relevant or that the Claims Administrator deems necessary, if applicable.

Third, you must sign the Claim Form, which will include a declaration that the information contained in the Claim Form and the Proof of Claim are accurate and truthful.

You must submit to the Claims Administrator the duly completed Claim Form and Proof of Claim during the Claims Period, which shall start on September 14, 2026, and end on January 12, 2027. All Claims received after the Claims Period will be automatically refused.
